Mr. Tramontozzi gave an overview of this item and there was a brief discussion.

This amendment is coming to the BOR because the architectural fee will now be above \$100K for the project. This is due to the expanded scope of adding four "gang" style student bathrooms as requested by the BOE.

The new budget for this project is now approximately \$2.74M. The bathroom work will be \$850K for all four bathrooms total.

The architectural fee will be 7.4% of the total construction cost.

The building where the bathrooms are located was built in 1927 with wood framing. The bathrooms need to be completely rebuilt with steel framing, concrete foundations, and new fixtures. Asbestos abatement will be performed.

The City will be applying for a State grant and that requires the bathrooms be brought up to ADA standards and current codes.

A motion to approve Item #1 was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Cottrell, Shaw, Di Costanzo, Mays, and Pollack in favor).
