The members of the Social Services Commission unanimously support the hiring of a Social Services Coordinator for the City of Stamford as presented by Mr. Ted Jankowski, Director of Public Health, Safety and Welfare 2015 budget. The elimination of this position in previous budget years has significantly reduced services to Stamford residents in need of assistance.

As members of the Social Services Commission, we can testify to the urgent need for a paid coordinator to assist the overly burdened social services department. A key role of the Social Service Coordinator is to organize, maximize and share resources with other social services agencies in the City. These not-for-profit agencies provide valuable support to our residents. Sadly, leaving the Coordinator position vacant over the last few years has significantly reduced opportunities to serve residents in need. Filling this role will benefit many residents by coordinating existing services, reduce redundant programming and identify gaps in service delivery. The benefits of re-hiring a Social Services Coordinator will undoubtedly exceed the investment in the position.
