




Budget for FY 23/24 \$1,100,000

Department Request for FY 23/24 was \$1,100,000

FY 22/23 Actual spend \$1,041,206

\$660,000 or 54% of the budget has been spent

67% through the year (bills received for work through February)

Estimated need through year end is approximately \$1,100,000

School Mold litigation has cost \$171,000 to date or 16% of the budget



Statistics FY 22/23



- 217 pending litigation matters & 137 pending tax appeals as of March 1, 2024
- 194 property tax appeals relating to the October
 1, 2022 revaluation
- 128 Claims filed (i.e., pothole, vehicular incidents, slip & fall)
- 21 formal public legal opinions, hundreds of informal legal opinions
- \$126k collected for damage to City property
