IN ADDITION, that Caroline Simmons, as Mayor of the City of Stamford, is authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all documents on behalf of the City of Stamford and to do and perform all acts and things which she deems to be necessary or appropriate to carry out the terms of such documents, including, but not limited to, executing and delivering all agreements and documents necessary to said grant with DEEP.

BE IT FURTHER CERTIFIED THAT Caroline Simmons was elected Mayor and that her term of office began on December 1, 2021 and will continue until November 30, 2025. As the Mayor, Caroline Simmons serves as the Chief Executive Officer for the City of Stamford and on _______, 2025 has both the authority and the office to enter into agreements on behalf of the City of Stamford and to sign on behalf of the City of Stamford for financial assistance to improve Boccuzzi Park.
