REVIEW Status of Outstanding Funds Awarded to the City Through Grants and the Timeline and Process Associated with Receiving Them. 11/03/15 – Submitted by Rep. Quinones REPORT MADE

Ms. Cammarota reviewed the process the Grants office uses for projects in the report for which the City does not receive funds and the most recent grants report.

- They currently have 7 school construction projects they are trying to close out with the State
- The state audits projects over \$5,000,000 which slows things down
- 99% of the time, they expend the funds first and then get reimbursed, so there is always a lag
- The office no longer has a full time school grants person, which slows down the process
- The reimbursement request is usually the responsible of the grant office, which works better than having the department be responsible
- Some projects, such as the Strawberry Hill School, could receive progress payments
- The amount outstanding as of December 2014 was \$46 million, this money will ultimately be reimbursed
- It is infrequent for the City not to be reimbursed
