The Fiscal Committee met as indicated above. In attendance were Chair Di Costanzo; Committee Member Reps. Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller and Mitchell. Absent or excused were Committee Member Reps. Cerasoli, Coleman, Quinones and Silver. Also present were Rep. Ryan; Jay Fountain, OPM; and Sergeant Andrew Gallagher, Stamford Police Department.

Mr. Fountain distributed the attached handout. He explained that

- This request is usually made in January, but there is retroactive pay to be made in the first 6 months of the year
- This would be for retroactive pay through June 30, 2016

- They have used \$4,386,747, but there is an additional of \$4,157,960 needed in the assigned fund balance to cover all of the contracts
- They had put enough in contingency set aside to cover this, but it was not transferred to fund balance (usually done in January after audit)
- This money comes from 2016 contingency
- Everything that is left in contingency at the end of the fiscal year becomes unassigned fund balance which is then assigned
- There are six outstanding contracts
- This amount includes the Fire and Police contracts

Sergeant Gallagher discussed this item with the Committee as follows:

- This is a win/win for the City and will solve three problems in the Police Department-
  - Improves efficiency for police officers on the road by allowing them to use computerized information they receive on the road and populate a ticket electronically which will print to a ticket in the car (30 cars already have printers), providing for clearer handwriting and fewer mistakes
  - The ticket is then transmitted to records management automatically where it is populated, so that clerks at the desk in the police department do not have to input data from a handwritten ticket
  - It will then transmit automatically to the state, rather than being mailed or handwritten and after being disposed of in court, it returns electronically and is automatically linked to the file
- The annual maintenance cost is estimated at \$6,000-7,000.
- The Police Department brings in over \$110,000 in fine revenue each year
- The grants resolution for this was already approved
- The State pursues people who don't pay tickets
- The City gets a percentage back per violation (generally \$15 per violation, but \$40 for use of cell phones)
