Mr. Toma stated that the Board of Finance had recommended a limit of \$2.2 million, which was the same as the amount approved by the Board of Representatives in the ordinance approved in March.

In response to questions from the committee, Ms. Dennies stated that the eligibility requirements for this program have not been increased since 2015, and the limit has not been met in the past as a result. They anticipate meeting the limit this time.

Committee members had extensive discussions with Ms. Dennies about how seniors will be informed about the availability of this program.

A motion to approve Item No. 1 was made, seconded, and approved by a vote of 7-0-0 (Reps. Di Costanzo, Miller; Boeger, Coleman, Figueroa, and Tomas in favor.
