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A motion to approve Item No. 3 (F32.091) was made, seconded, and Mr. Stackpole and Mr. Parenti both presented on this item. Afterwards, there was discussion on the item resulting in a motion to go into Executive Session (Goldberg) to discuss vendor specific questions inviting all members of the Fiscal Committee and ex-officio members present, Greg Stackpole, Assessor, and Steven Parenti, Deputy Assessor. The motion was seconded (Zachary) and approved by a voice vote of 8-0-0 (Co-Chairs Morson and Zachary and Committee Reps. Bouchard, de la Cruz, Dorsey, Goldberg, Johnson and Lapine approved).
