LEGAL NOTICE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT - STAMFORD CDBG PROGRAM COMMENTS ON A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The Housing Authority City of Stamford dba Charter Oak Communities (COC) was awarded \$49,500 in CDBG funds, subject to final budget approval, during the Year 43 (2017-2018) budget process. Funds are for a hot water boiler replacement project at Scofield Manor, 614 Scofieldtown Rd. The boiler provides domestic hot water for bathing, laundry, cooking and sanitation to all 50 low income, elderly and/or disabled residents. The boiler is now experiencing a major leak in one of the sections and system failure is imminent. Due to the emergency nature of the situation, COC has asked to access CDBG funds from prior years that were to be reprogrammed in Year 43 to undertake the emergency replacement of the hot water boiler in the current year (Year 42 2016-2017).

In accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 91.105 Citizen participation plan; local governments, interested citizens must be provided an opportunity to comment on any substantial amendment for a period of not less than 30 days before the amendment is implemented. The period for citizens to provide comments on the allocation listed above is officially open as of the date of this notice and will remain open until April 25, 2017. Any person wishing to comment on the Substantial Amendment may do so in writing between March 23, 2017 and the public hearing date or may appear and be heard at the time and place noted below. Written comments should be sent to the Community Development Office, 888 Washington Blvd., Stamford, CT 06904 or via email to elarsen@stamfordct.gov with the subject Substantial Amendment Comment: Scofield.

In addition, citizens may provide their comments during a public hearing scheduled on April 25, 2017 at 6:30 pm on the 4th floor of the Stamford Government Center, 888 Washington Blvd. Anyone having special needs in order to participate in the public meeting should call Erik Larson at 203-977-4053 by April 19, 2017 to make arrangements. Under local Stamford procedures, the substantial amendment must be approved by the Mayor and the HUD/SS Committee. The HUD/SS Committee will act on this item during their April meeting. A summary of the comments and a summary of any comment not accepted and the reasons for such will be attached to the substantial amendment and submitted to HUD.
