PY2020 CDBG/CARES ACT FUNDING**

CDBG-CV FUNDING AVAILABILITY: In response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Office of Community Planning and Development has notified the City of Stamford that it will receive an allocation of \$574,820 in CDBG-CV funding to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act, Public Law 116-136, which was signed by the President on March 27, 2020, to respond to the growing effects of this historic public health crisis.

The City of Stamford Community Development Office is currently accepting proposals from interested nonprofit organizations and municipal government agencies for CDBG-CV funding, to be used during Program Year 2020. Program Year 2020 runs from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

Completed proposals for 2020 CDBG-CV funding consideration must be received by the Community Development Office no later than June 8, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. via email. Do not mail/fax/drop off hard copies of applications as no one is in the Community Development Office to receive them at this time. Proposed activities must comply with CDBG eligibility requirements, with the majority of the primary beneficiaries meeting the criteria for low- and moderate-income persons (pursuant to HUD income guidelines), and must be used to prevent, prepare for and/or respond to the COVID-19 outbreak. Applications for funding will be available on the City of Stamford website via the Community Development page. For further details, instructions, or inquiries contact the Community Development Office by email: tpetrocelli@stamfordct.gov.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: The City of Stamford will accept comments on the use of its PY2020 CDBG and CDBG-CV funding through May 27, 2020. Public comments should be emailed to tpetrocelli@stamfordct.gov.

PUBLIC HEARING: The Board of Representatives and the CDBG Committee will host a virtual public hearing on June 15, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. to solicit comment and input regarding the use of PY2020 CDBG and CDBG-CV funding.
