YEAR 49 PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME) JULY 1, 2023 - JUNE 30, 2024

Within the context of the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) objective for the development of viable urban communities, the City of Stamford has established the following goal for the utilization of HUD funds: to provide expanded housing and economic opportunities for low income individuals residing in Stamford, and improve public services and public facilities servicing this population and the low income neighborhoods of Stamford.

In order to address the above goal, CDBG funds projects or services in the Primary Functional Areas of Housing, Public Facilities and Economic Development at a minimum of 65%, Public Services at a maximum of 15%, and Administration and Planning at a maximum of 20%.

For YEAR 49, the City of Stamford expects to receive an entitlement grant estimated to be \$877,693 for CDBG and \$493,472 for HOME.

Written proposals for YEAR 49 funding are due to the Stamford Community Development Office (SCDO) on or before Friday, January 20, 2023, to egordon@stamfordct.gov.

All applicants must present their proposals at the Virtual Public Hearing on Tuesday, January 31, 2023, at 6:30pm where the Mayor and the Housing, Community Development and Social Services Committee (HCD/SS) of the Board of Representatives will hear suggestions on how HUD funds should be spent. The purpose of the hearing is to hear comments on the needs of the City of Stamford for housing, economic development, public improvements and public services for low income residents; review the CDBG legislation including regulations concerning eligible activities; receive citizen comments on the Community Development Plan, Citizen Participation Plan, CDBG/HOME performance, and suggestions for the use of HUD funds. Agencies and individuals must present their proposals for the use of CDBG funds for which they have submitted an application to the Stamford Community Development Office.
