NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 31st BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT THE APPROVED PROGRAMS ATTACHED HERETO CONSTITUTE A LIST WHICH SHALL BE SUMBITTED ON OR BEFORE July 1, 2024 to the Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Revenue Services for participation in the Neighborhood Assistance Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, Caroline Simmons, acting through the City's Grants Officer, Anita Carpenter, shall be the designee in accordance with the legislation to provide such additional information as may be required to oversee implementation of the resulting programs receiving private business contributions under the Act. Said programs shall not discriminate on the basis of race. color, religious creed, age, marital status, national origin, ancestry, sex, intellectual disability, sexual orientation, or physical disability in the provision of services.

This resolution shall become effective upon its enactment.
