Chair Mitchell called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

- Mayor Martin spoke briefly on the CDBG funding. He stated the City does not know the exact amount of funding that will be allocated, but in previous years they have had reductions. The City of Stamford will focus the limited funding on programs that effectively and efficiently benefit residents with low income. He encouraged public improvements and housing agencies to focus on safety issues and urgent repairs that cannot be deferred for another year.
- The Agencies on the [attached spreadsheet](#) presented requests for CDBG funding.
- Ross Burkhardt of New Neighborhood was late because of the Inspirica Function but was able to present at the end of the meeting.
- The YMCA was not present at the time of their presentation; a phone call was made to them with no response therefore making the request for funding ineligible.
- Chair Mitchell created 2 sub-committees that will meet on Thursday, February 19, 2015.

- On Saturday, March 14, the committee will meet with the Mayor or his representative to discuss its recommendations.
