Administrator Sawch provided an update:

- The new housing assistance program is in development, expected to open for applications by mid-next month.
- The program targets owner-occupied homes owned by low-income residents who meet HUD income guidelines.
- It will address urgent housing needs with a funding cap of \$10,000 per project.
- Eligible project types:
 - Roof and window repairs.
 - Hot water heater replacements.
 - o Handicap accessibility improvements.
 - Emergency plumbing and electrical updates to meet code.
- The program offers forgivable loans:
 - o If the property is sold within five years, the loan must be repaid to the city.
 - o After five years, the loan is forgiven.
- All participating properties must have updated smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
 Stamford FD will assist with installation.
- The City is compiling a list of licensed, insured, and SAM.gov-registered contractors willing to work with the program.
- The City will pay contractors directly, not the homeowners, based on the assumption that homeowners lack liquid capital.
- Administrator Sawch will notify the board once application reviews begin, which is expected by the end of October.
