12. LR29.052 ORDINANCE, for publication; Amending Chapter 111. Held in Committee Public Safety and Animal Welfare. 6-0-0

Secondary Committee: Public Safety & Health

Chair Heaphy outlined the highlights of the proposed changes to the Ordinance, based upon the work of the Animal Control Task Force with input from the administration, the animal welfare groups and members of the public. The main changes are a switch from an agricultural focus; tightening up the language of the language on enclosures of livestock; ( took out including) a section on tethering of dogs; more details on dangerous dogs; the addition of a section on cats, including feral cats; also a new section to address some of the concerns raised about rabbits; a new section on the animal control and care center, including a surrender policy; a new section on the responsibility of pet owners; and a new section on breeding of domesticated pets.

- Committee members discussed the various changes with Chief Shaw and Mr. Toma, including:
- The slaughtering of rabbits for food
- whether 111.8.C should be broken into separate parts
- the provision prohibiting the sale of baby rabbits, which only applies to public property
- enforcement issues
- The exemption in 111-4.C.2 is intended to deal with emergency situations
- 111-6.C.3.b. may need to be reworded to remove the word teasing
- 111-11.D should be eliminated
- An ambiguity in the penalty provisions e.g., the \$100 fine in 111-7 and the civil citation process in 111-13makes sense – the phrase "unless otherwise provided herein," should be added to the beginning of 111-13
