## **Committee Report**

The Legislative & Rules Committee met as indicated above. In attendance were Chair Lee, Vice Chair Coleman and Committee Member Reps. Fedeli, Jacobson, Lion, Miller, Nabel and Zelinsky. Absent or excused was Committee Member Rep. Pia. Also present were Reps. Di Costanzo and Morson; Michael Toma, Law Department; and 4 members of the public. See the public hearing sign-in sheet.

Chair Lee called the meeting to order at 6:37 p.m.

Chair Lee opened the public hearing. Mr. Papa spoke in favor of the proposed ordinance. There being no other members of the present, Chair Lee closed the public hearing. Since members of the public arrived a few minutes later, Chair Lee reopened the public hearing later in the meeting.

Committee members discussed issues that had been raised by retailers, as follows:

- There may be an issue with the requirement of "conspicuous notation" would language of any kind be sufficient?
- Are the bags being distributed by Shop Rite consistent with the proposed increase to 12 mils; they are 10.25 mils and plastic but are washable and so would fit within that definition of reusable and the thickness of the plastic is not relevant

Rep. Nabel made a motion to change 12 mil to 10 mil which motion was seconded.

Chair Lee reopened the public hearing. Ms. Menendez and Ms. Love spoke in support of the proposed ordinance. There being no further speakers, the public hearing was closed.

Rep. Nabel withdrew her motion to amend and the second was withdrawn.

A motion to approve the ordinance for final adoption was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 8-0-0 (Reps. Lee, Coleman, Fedeli, Jacobson, Lion, Miller, Nabel and Zelinsky in favor).

It was noted that the ordinance goes into effect on May 3, 2019.
