West Main Street Pedestrian Bridge Revised Agreement/SOW with WMC

President Quinones and Chairman Jacobson,

As you know, there has been a request to clarify a few terms in the above referenced agreement. In response thereto, the City has entered into a revised agreement with Wengell, McDonnell & Costello for the design of the West Main Street pedestrian bridge. Signed and red-lined versions of that, revised Agreement and Scope of Work are attached hereto.

The changes to the Agreement and SOW make it clear that the subject bridge will be designed to accommodate light emergency vehicles, such as a police car or an ambulance, and that historic preservation compliance shall be the City's responsibility. There are no other substantive changes. All changes are included in the red-line versions.

Finally, please note that, per Sec. 23-18.4 of the City's Code of Ordinances, the revised agreement, if approved by a majority vote of the entire Board of Representatives, does not need to be approved by the Board of Finance. Should the Agreement be approved by this Committee and, subsequently, by less than a majority of the entire BOR, the Agreement will, at that time, be submitted to the BOF for its consideration.
