Thirty-five dollars and twenty-six (\$35.26) per each one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of estimated cost or fraction thereof above one million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) of estimated cost per permit

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that commercial building permit fees for the first 1 million three hundred thousand dollars of estimated cost, reduced building permit fees for developments containing affordable housing units, and residential building permit fees are to be unchanged and will remain the fees that were previously set by resolution 3972 in 2019.
