Mr. Tom Turk explained that this agreement is for the assessment of road conditions in Stamford. This company will implement a pavement management system to be used to analyze road conditions. Mr. Turk explained that there's more to take into consideration than just the surface of the road. There are set points which determine the type of treatment that will be selected given the current or predicted condition of the road over time; budget; volume; and length of the road before making a decision on what will be repaved. Mr. Turk believes this service would add value to the City.

Rep. Mahoney would like more information on the results from the last assessment in 2001. Mr. Turk agreed to talk to Lou Casolo regarding the last management company and their results.

Rep. Zelinsky asked if they take into consideration utility company road construction. Mr. Turk stated they consult with utility companies before any paving work begins. He said because of unforeseen circumstances the City may pave a road and not long after the utility company will need to make a repair. Mr. Turk said this will be an ongoing problem.

A motion to hold this item was made and seconded and failed by a vote of 3-3-0. (Reps. Coleman, Mahoney and McMullen in favor; Reps. Coppola, Liebson and Zelinsky opposed)
