- The City has reached out to Michael Baker to assess the project for a fee of less than \$25,000
- After the receipt of the assessment, they will come back to discuss the options with the committee
- The bridge has heavy pedestrian use
- The Mill River should weigh in on this
- The bids received are best offers
- The assessment results should be shared with the Committee
- The strategic assessment should assess whether or not it is worth it to restore this historic bridge and what other options are available
