Representative Stella voiced his disappointment:

- Expressed deep disappointment over the dismantling of the historic West Main Street Bridge, dating back to 1888.
- Noted over six years of discussion and advocacy from the 30th board, with no resolution or repair plan.
- Criticized the City's lack of commitment, citing missed grant opportunities and inadequate funding.
- Highlighted failed efforts to preserve or repurpose the bridge, including a misleading "temporary" replacement.
- Pointed out disparities in grant support for other Stamford bridges, suggesting neglect of the West Side.

• Emphasized the bridge's cultural and historical significance, lamenting its loss as a failure of preservation.

A motion to recommit Item 2 was made, seconded, and approved by a vote of 5-0-0 (Vice-Chair Tomas, Reps. Graham, Mays, Stella, and Watkins in favor).
