RESOLUTION NO. 3829

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF "FITNESS ZONE" EXERCISE EQUIPMENT TO BE INSTALLED IN COVE ISLAND PARK

WHEREAS, Section C2-10-2(7) of the City Charter authorizes the Board of Representatives, in the name of the City, to receive gifts of money or property; and,

WHEREAS, The Trust for Public Land ["the Donor"], a non-profit California public benefit land conservation organization which operates a "Parks for People Program", wishes to provide and install exercise equipment known as a "Fitness Zone" in Cove Island Park for the use of residents; and

WHEREAS, all of the costs of such exercise equipment, the installation thereof, construction management, and the review of the installation and operation of the equipment by a third-party safety expert shall be paid for by The Trust for Public Land, via a grant received from the Steven and Alexandra Cohen Foundation; and


WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission has approved the installation of such exercise equipment in Cove Island Park, and the location of the Fitness Zone within the park; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to accept such gift from the Donor;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 29TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Pursuant to Section C2-10-2(7) of the City Charter, the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to accept the gift of the above described Fitness Zone exercise equipment and the installation of such exercise equipment within Cove Island Park, from the Donor.
