PROPOSED RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING APPLICATION PERMIT FEES AND FEES FOR COMMERCIAL VESSELS IN WATERWAYS OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD

ENABLING LEGISLATION: Pursuant to Sec. 22a-113s of the Connecticut Statutes, Article 6-65 of the Code of the City of Stamford and Chapter 3, Section 3 Part 4 of the Stamford Harbor Management Plan.

WHEREAS – the City of Stamford has determined it to be in its best interest to establish application fees for waterfront applications and transit fees for commercial vessels entering and leaving Stamford Harbor and other city waterways

WHEREAS – The Stamford Harbor Management Commission met on March 21, 2017 and approved such fees as set forth below

A) APPLICATION FEES FOR REVIEW AND RESPONSE TO APPLICATIONS REFERRED BY STATE OF CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION:

FULL DEEP PERMIT – Construction of docks, piers bulkheads, rip rap walls or any structure that requires land use approval or building permit

SINGLE FAMILY - \$100

MULTI-FAMILY COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL - \$200

B) APPLICATION FEES FOR REVIEW AND RESPONSE TO APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED BY THE STAMFORD ZONING BOARD UNDER COASTAL SITE PLAN REVIEW PROCESS:

SINGLE FAMILY ZONED - \$50

MULTI-FAMILY, COMMERCIAL, AND INDUSTRIAL- \$100

C) FEES FOR BARGES/TUGBOATS/TANKERS TRANSITING STAMFORD WATERWAYS:

PER ROUND TRIP - \$50

A trip is defined as an entry and an exit, or an exit and an entry of said commercial vessel

Each commercial landing or portside destination to be charged annually as a percentage of total yearly trips as determined from commercial vessel records.
