Co-Chair Franzetti called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

<sup>3</sup>The Committee discussed this item. Mr. Fedeli explained that the Harbor Commission no longer has City funding. State statue mandates that a substantial amount of fee structure must administrate the Commission and be put back into the harbor for safety and improvements. The Commission is proposing two types of user fees. One fee is for permits for structures on/near the Harbor Commission Management Plan area. The second fee is \$50 per round trip for commercial vessels. The two biggest commercial users of the Harbor are O&G and Rubino Brothers. Enhanced harbor safety is important. The Commission has offered to fund another shift of the marine police. Dr. Ortelli explained that dredging studies need to be done. Mr. Fedeli will provide ongoing financial updates to the Committee.

Harbor Master Eric Knott asked that the attached <u>statement</u> be submitted into the minutes.

A motion to hold this item for one month was made, seconded and failed by a vote of 2-4-2 (Reps. Giordano and Heaphy in favor; Reps. Caterbone, McGarry, Pratt and Ryan opposed; and Reps. Franzetti and Mahoney abstaining).

A motion to approve this item was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 6-0-2 (Reps. Caterbone, Giordano, Mahoney, McGarry, Pratt and Ryan in favor; Reps. Franzetti and Heaphy abstaining).
