**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE  
AMENDING SECTION 164-6, PROHIBITED NOISE ACTIVITIES**

This ordinance amends Chapter 164, Section 164-6 of the Code of Ordinances to prohibit all mobile sources operating when not in motion, or idling, for more than 3 minutes, except: 1) when the mobile source is forced to remain motionless because of traffic conditions or mechanical difficulties; 2) when it is necessary to operate heating, cooling or auxiliary equipment installed on the mobile source in order to accomplish the intended use of the mobile source; 3) to bring the mobile source to the manufacturer's recommended operating temperature; 4) When the outdoor temperature is below 20°F; or 5) when the mobile source is being repaired.

This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection, as required by CGS §22a-73(c). This document is prepared for the benefit of the public, solely for purposes of information, summarization and explanation. This document does not represent the intent of the legislative body of the City of Stamford for any purpose.
