**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE  
CONCERNING MOISTURE AND RAINFALL SENSORS  
AND NOTIFICATION OF SHUT OFF INSTRUCTIONS  
FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEMS**

This ordinance adds a new Chapter 239, Irrigation Systems to the Code of Ordinances to 1) require that each newly installed irrigation system have a rain/moisture sensor that suspends operation of the system during periods of moisture or rainfall; 2) that during repairs of existing irrigation systems that require replacement of the control box and/or the entire system, the installer shall install a rain/moisture sensor that suspends operation of the system during periods of moisture or rainfall; and 3) at the time of installation, routine maintenance or repair of an irrigation system, the installer shall affix a system to the system's control panel with instructions for shutting off the system. The ordinance further provides a penalty of \$100 for each violation.
