## RESOLUTION NO.SETTING FEES FOR MISCELLANEOUS HEALTH INSPECTIONS AND TESTING

**WHEREAS**, Chapter Sec. 143 of the Code of Ordinances provides for an administrative fee for miscellaneous health inspections and testing; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 143-13 of the Code of Ordinances provides that said fees shall be set by Resolution of the Board of Representatives.

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 2596, the Board of Representatives approved fees for miscellaneous health inspections and tests on July 5, 2000; and

**WHEREAS**, the inspections and testing performed by the Health Department have changed and the administrative costs of performing miscellaneous health inspections and testing has significantly increased; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to delete some fees and increase other fees for miscellaneous health inspections and testing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, pursuant to Sec. 143-13 of the Code of Ordinances, does hereby approve the following fee Schedule:

Animal Transportation for Rabies Testing Stamford residents	\$0	\$90.00
Animal Transportation for Rabies Testing Non-resident	\$0	\$125.00
Annual Indoor Pool Inspection	\$0	\$300.00
Annual Outdoor Pool Inspection	\$0	\$200.00
