Committee members discussed the current water levels with Dr. Calder and Mr. Jankowski. They explained that the water levels are improving but there is an ongoing conservation effort. The two big factors which contributed to the current drought are nature and the use of irrigation systems. These sensors cost between \$70 and \$200. A motion to approve this ordinance was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 4-0-2 (Reps. Quinones, Giraldo, Moore and Zelinsky in favor; Reps. Caterbone and Coppola abstaining).
