Captain Dohmann discussed the alcohol ordinance statistics for 2023/2024.

- 41 tickets were issued between June 2023 through December 2024.
  - Issuance by race:
    - White: 5 (16.1%)
    - Black: 10 (32.3%)
    - Latino: 26 (51.6%)
  - Issuance by known gender:
    - Male: 29 (93.5%)
    - Female: 2 (6.5%)
  - Issuance by location:
    - Westside: 35 (85.4%)
    - Downtown: 3 (7.3%)
    - Waterside: 3 (7.3%)

There has been a 64% decline in issuance over the last six months.

A motion to approve Item 1 was made, seconded, and approved by a vote of 8-0-0 (Chair Stella, Vice-Chair Morson, Reps. Phil Berns, Campbell, Camporeale, Graham, Pavia, and Pollack in favor).
