Mr. Pickering distributed the attached <u>2017 WestCOG Annual report</u>. He reviewed the report and discussed the COG with the Committee as follows:

- Councils of Governments differ from Regional Planning Agencies in that the municipal chief executive officers on their boards; in 2013 the State converted all RPAs to COGS and required each have at least 14 members
- WestCOG has been operating for 3 years
- COGs have almost all of the powers of municipalities including zoning and police powers
- WestCOG is the 2nd largest COG and the only one growing in terms of population and economically
- The primary focus is to serve as a host for a metropolitan planning organization (any federal transportation dollars spent in a metropolitan area require the approval of a MPO under federal law)
- The General Assembly is pushing the COGs toward regionalism
