**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 231, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 6,
PROHIBITED STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING, TO PROHIBIT
PARKING ON CITY STREETS FOR MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED
AND TWENTY HOURS**

This ordinance amends Chapter 231, Article 1, Section 231-6 of the Code of Ordinances to provide that it shall be a Class II violation for any person to park or leave standing, any vehicle upon any public street in the City for 120 or more consecutive hours. Any vehicle that is not moved within 24 hours after the issuance of a notice of violation of this restriction shall be deemed abandoned, and subject to removal in accordance with Section 231-16:
