SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
AMENDING 5231-45.1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SEASONAL,
PLANNED TEMPORARY, AND EMERGENCY
TEMPORARY RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS
TO ADD ONE-DAY EVENT RESIDENTIAL PARKING EXCEPTION

This ordinance amends Section 231-45.1 of the Code of Ordinances to permit residents to apply for a 24 hour exception to the residential permit program at least 15 days prior to a planned event. The resident seeking such an exception 1) must apply at least 15 days prior to the day of the exception; 2) pay \$50.00 per exception; and 3) place and remove exception signage provided by the City. There shall be no more than five exceptions per month in each Residential Parking Permit zone and each household shall be limited to one exception per month. The Stamford Police Department will be informed of any such exception by the Director of Operations.
