According to Chief of Staff Pollard, the bridge is 110 years old and must be rebuilt and the current ramp must be relocated. The Law Department has said that the State can take the property. The project is ready to proceed, and it would be in the best interest of the City to approve the resolution. Representative Kooris was concerned about retaining crosswalks, signage directing people to the downtown and traffic patterns. State Engineer Brown assured the committee that crosswalks will be in place, and striping and signage will be installed, directing people to the downtown area.

A motion to approve this resolution was made, seconded and approve by unanimous vote (Reps. DeLuca, Adams, Coleman, Giordano, Franzetti, Kolenberg and Kooris in favor.
