Chair DeLuca called the meeting to order at 7:30pm

A motion was made, seconded and approved to change the Agenda order and take up Item #2 first, by a vote of 6-0-0 (Reps. DeLuca, Pratt, Franzetti, Giordano, Kolenberg and Patterson in favor).

Mr. Cazano spoke in favor of the Trail. He stated this is the first step in the project. Mr. Benson said the State is leading a feasibility study and when the study is released, there will be more specific information about the trail. As of now the City has not been asked to contribute any funds, as presumably this will be a State project. He said that he is in support of this project, as it will be of benefit to Stamford. Committee members and representatives then discussed the project. A motion to approve this item was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 7-1-0 (Reps. DeLuca, Pratt, Di Costanzo, Franzetti, Giordano, Kolenberg and Moore in favor; Rep. Patterson opposed).

Chair DeLuca opened the public hearing. Three members of the public spoke in opposition of the resolution. Chair DeLuca then closed the public hearing. Committee members, representatives and Mr. Benson discussed the resolution. Brought up in the discussion was the subject of non-Stamford residents being allowed to have monthly permits. Mr. Benson said the waiting list for permits for the Glenbrook lot is about 150 people and Springdale lot is about 275 people. He will be making a recommendation to the permitting office that 25 additional Glenbrook permits and 25 additional Springdale permits be issued, due to vacancies his department has noted in the lots during the day. A motion to hold this item was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 8-0-0 (Reps. DeLuca, Pratt, Di Costanzo, Franzetti, Giordano, Kolenberg, Moore and Patterson in favor).
