Committee members discussed Item No. 1 with the invited guests. Items discussed included the following:

- Complaints regarding overnight parking of large commercial vehicles in residential neighborhoods have been received in most districts
- Ordinance is vague and needs to be updated and clarified
- The Committee is sensitive to the fact that parking regulation changes can potentially have adverse effects on small business owners with commercial vehicles
- Some complaints received are zoning enforcement issues
- Vikki Cooper agreed the ordinance is confusing and needs to be modified to be clear to understand

After discussion the Committee decided it would like the Opinion of the Law Department on what changes or clarifications to the parking regulations the Committee can propose without violating State or local laws or Zoning Regulations. Chair Watkins agreed to make such a request of the Law Department.
