Chair Watkins opened the public hearing and Kieran Edmonson spoke in favor of this ordinance.

Frank Petise spoke briefly about the current truck ordinance; as it exists today, the prohibitions relate to having a weight limit of 18,000 pounds for vehicles on residential streets. After research, it was decided the weight limit should be 12,000 pounds, which allows smaller personal trucks and family SUV's but will exclude the larger trucks that represent safety concerns and are the ones that residents complain about. Mr. Petise assured the committee that they would be able to enforce the new ordinance with the newly hired violation officers.

The Committee was concerned about getting the information out to residents. Mr. Petise stated he could put announcements on the website with a set start date; use warning tickets and work with the Mayor's Social Media team to get out to residents.

A motion to approve this item was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 6-0-0. (Reps. Watkins, Adams, Di Costanzo, Gilbride, Grunberger, and Moore in favor).
