- The community building grant to prevent gun violence and the need for community involvement

- The Law Department is still working on the street opening ordinance
- The fees charged for blocking of streets and sidewalks
- Parking meter zones
- Flashing “no turn on red” signs
- The parking rates at Glenbrook and Springdale
