Mayor Martin discussed the following items with members of the Board of Representatives:

- The City only went to high deductible health plans recently, it is too early and too complex to evaluate
- The proposed ordinance regarding the demolition of unsafe buildings is not a change in policy but includes the policy in the ordinance
- The administration is resubmitting Land Use fees which are closer to the fees previously requested; the fees are not punitive but recognize the difference between commercial developers and single family homeowners
- The administration has included a provision for the administration to adjust fees for inflation, which is being reviewed by the legal department
