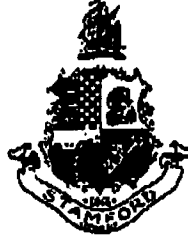

PARADE ORDERS MEMORIAL DAY PARADE ~ SUNDAY, MAY 28, 2017

******SUMMER STREET WILL CLOSE AT 10:30 A.M.******

1. Assemble **NO LATER** than 11:00 a.m. on Hoyt Street at Summer Street. Parade will commence at 12:00 p.m.
2. **ALL BANDS AND MARCHING UNITS ARE TO DROP OFF AT SUMMER AND OAK STREET VEHICLES MUST TURN LEFT ONTO OAK STREET TO EXIT THE PARADE ROUTE.**
******PLEASE INFORM BUS DRIVERS OF THIS NOTICE******

NO BUSES OR ANY VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO PROCEED BEYOND OAK STREET, PARKING IS AVAILABLE IN THE LOT AT OAK AND SUMMER STREET.

PLEASE PLAN YOUR ARRIVAL ACCORDINGLY

3. Personnel in charge of units are required to: Assemble units in assigned position outlined in the accompanying Parade Marching Orders and maintain proper decorum.
4. All schools and marching units will display the American Flag at the front of their unit. **Proper dress code is required. SHORTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE WORN.**
5. In the event of an emergency, marchers will move to the extreme right of the street; stay within their unit and wait further instructions.
6. The Reviewing stand will be located on Atlantic street prior to the entrance to Veterans Park. Reviewing officers will be City and State officials and the Grand Marshall.
7. Units not participating in the Veterans' ceremony will continue to march up Atlantic Street and disband on Bell Street.
