To apply for your U.S. passport, you must:

- Renewing a passport
 - Bring a completed Passport Application Form **DS-82**
 - Submit your old passport
 - Provide one recent passport photo – 2x2
 - Pay passport Fees **(no cash)**
- 1st Time application
 - Bring a completed Passport Application Form **DS-11**
 - Submit your original Birth Certificate or Naturalization Certificate (your certificate will be mailed to the address on your DS-11 Application)
 - Provide one recent passport photo – 2x2
 - Present valid photo identification – (Driver's License, State Identification Card, Employee ID or Military ID)
 - Pay passport fees **(no cash)**

U.S. Passport Book: Valid for international travel by air, sea, and land.

Validity: 10 years for adults (age 16 & older)

5 years for minors (under age 16)

Cost for First Time Applicants: \$145 for adults (age 16 & older)

\$115 for minors (under age 16)

Cost for Renewal Applicants: \$110 for adults (age 16 & older)
