**WHEREAS**, Arnold Weiss has been a member of the Military Auxiliary Radio Systems, a network of amateur radio operators who provide free telephone communications between members of the armed forces around the world and their stateside families; and

**WHEREAS**, Arnold Weiss has been married to Lenore for 52 years and has three children, has lived in Stamford since 1965, graduated with a degree in electrical engineering from the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn, went to work for Norden Systems in 1958, and retired in 1999.
