

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION  
HONORING THE LIFE OF JEFFREY T. CURTIS, SR.  
AND HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD**

**WHEREAS**, Jeffrey T. Curtis, Sr. was born and raised in Stamford, CT on December 4, 1955, and graduated from J.M. Wright Technical School in 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, Jeffrey T. Curtis, Sr. met his wife, Rose, here in Stamford, and they raised their two children, Christina and Jeffrey T. Curtis, Jr. in our community; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Curtis served as Operations Manager in Facilities Management at Stamford Hospital for 27 years, later continuing his career at Norwalk Hospital for 5 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Curtis became a part of the Board of Representatives, originally being appointed to fill a vacancy in the 9<sup>th</sup> district in 1992; and then went on to get elected in 1993, 1995, and 1997 serving until 1998 when he moved to the 14<sup>th</sup> district; and then later was elected in 2019 and was re-elected in 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1995, Curtis participated in Anti-Crime Vigil walks, neighborhood street cleanups, and was a Charter Member of the Stamford PD Citizen Police Academy; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure on the BOR, he served on numerous committees including Appointments, Operations, Urban Redevelopment, and Transportation, among others; and

**WHEREAS**, he took on leadership roles on the BOR by co-chairing the Public Works & Sewer Committee and Chairing the Public Safety & Health Committee; and most notably, served as the President of the Board of Representatives from December 2021 until his death on July 15, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as an Alternate on the Planning Board from 2004 to 2008; and served multiple terms on the Democratic City Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Curtis was very active in his Church community at Sacred Heart, where he once served as Parish Council President, led the parish's beloved annual carnival and spearheaded numerous fundraisers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 31<sup>st</sup> Board of Representatives honors the legacy and contributions that Jeffrey T. Curtis, Sr. made to the City of Stamford.
