

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
HONORING MARY LISA FEDELI
ON HER 30 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD
AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES**

WHEREAS, Mary Fedeli was first appointed to the Stamford Board of Representatives on March 1, 1995. She then went on to be elected in November of 1995 and has served her residents of District-17 with dedication, distinction, integrity, and unwavering devotion for thirty years; and

WHEREAS, Representative Fedeli was a thoughtful, steady voice for her constituents, demonstrating sound judgment, accessibility, and a consistent willingness to listen, collaborate, and lead. Throughout her service, she worked tirelessly to advance the wellbeing of the community, championing policies that strengthened neighborhoods, supported public services, and improved the quality of life for her constituents in Springdale, and designating Springdale to a Village Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, her dedication and service extended throughout the community through her active involvement with the **Springdale Neighborhood Association, Glenbrook Neighborhood Association, the Patient Family Advisory Board of Stamford Hospital, St. Clements Church, The Stamford Museum and Nature Center, and Keep Stamford Beautiful**. She worked closely with the **Springdale Neighborhood Association** and the **City of Stamford** to acquire the piece of property on Hope Street to keep it as open space and designate it as a **Park** where the **Annual Springdale Tree Lighting** takes place. She also worked tirelessly to convert a long-abandoned basketball court on Haig Avenue to a brand-new, state-of-the-art **Toddler Park**.

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives wishes to record its admiration for her accomplishments, gratitude for her service, and best wishes for health, happiness, and fulfillment in the years ahead. Although her service as an elected representative has concluded, the contributions, leadership, and positive impact of Mary Fedeli will be long remembered and appreciated by her colleagues, constituents, and the entire city of Stamford.
