RESOLUTION NO. 3416 CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO OVERSEE NORTH STAMFORD'S WATER CONTAMINATION SITUATION AND RELATED ISSUES

WHEREAS, there now exists in North Stamford a water contamination situation, in which elevated levels of dieldrin and chlordane has been found in well water samples collected from houses in the area, and hazardous substances have been found on the grounds of Scofieldtown Park, which could negatively impact the health and safety of the residents of the City of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor formed a "Scofieldtown Area Remediation Task Force" in October, 2009 to oversee the contamination situation in North Stamford and to provide guidance to City boards, commissions and the administration in addressing the contamination situation; and

WHEREAS, in November, 2010, the Mayor disbanded the Task Force stating that it had completed its mission; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City for there to be continued oversight of the contamination situation in North Stamford.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the 28th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford that the President of the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford appoint a special committee to oversee the water contamination issues in North Stamford and related issues; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consist of not less than five (5) members; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such special committee shall meet on a monthly basis at the discretion of the chair of the committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such special committee shall report back to the Board of Representatives with the following information:

1. What measures are being taken to address the water contamination situation and any related issues;
2. Whether there are additional measures the special committee believes should be taken to address the water contamination situation and any related issues; and


3. Recommendations for any legislation that may aid in resolving the water contamination situation and any related issues; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the report of such special committee shall be placed after the reports of the Standing Committees on the agenda of the monthly Board of Representatives meeting.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.
