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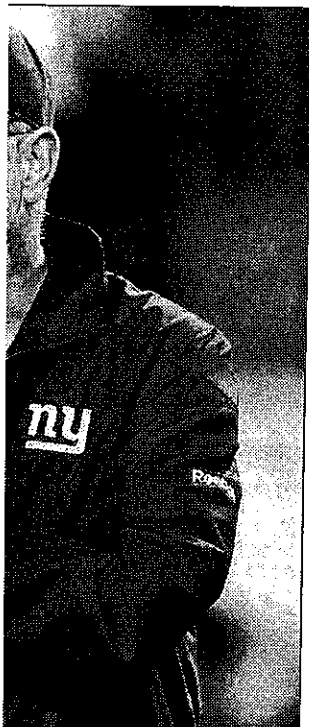

PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 231, ARTICLE V, SNOW EMERGENCIES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Chapter 231, Article V, of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 231-47. - Definitions.

For the purposes of this Article, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

Snow emergency. A situation wherein the Mayor of the City of Stamford has declared an emergency due to an expected or actual accumulation of snowfall or icing conditions such that effective and efficient removal and/or sanding and salting is necessary to ensure public safety.

Snow emergency route. A city street that has been designated by [a resolution of the City of Stamford Traffic Commission] the Director of Operations as a snow emergency route.

Sec. 231-48. - Power to declare; parking prohibited.

When, due to weather conditions, public safety requires the temporary suspension of parking within the whole or any portion of any designated street or highway of the city, the Mayor shall have the power to declare a snow emergency, and parking in said area(s) shall be prohibited or restricted.

Sec. 231-49. - Declaration; notice.

Declaration of a snow emergency shall be made, whenever practicable, at least three (3) hours in advance of the time that said snow emergency becomes effective. Notice of said declaration shall be given by publication in a newspaper or by broadcast through local radio stations.

Sec. 231-50. - Duration.

A declared snow emergency shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Mayor.

Sec. 231-51. - Establishment of snow emergency routes.

Whenever the [Traffic Commission] Director of Operations determines that parking on all or a portion of a city street during a snow emergency [as declared by the Mayor of the City of Stamford] would endanger the safety or welfare of the public, [said Commission] the Director of Operations may, by resolution, designate said street, or portion thereof, as a snow emergency route, and may specify the type of parking restriction to be in effect on such snow emergency route during a snow emergency. The Director of Operations shall notify the Board of Representatives of any such designation within ten (10) days of such designation.

Sec. 231-52. - Erection of signs and markings.
