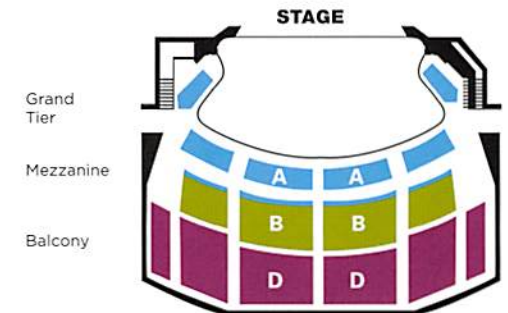
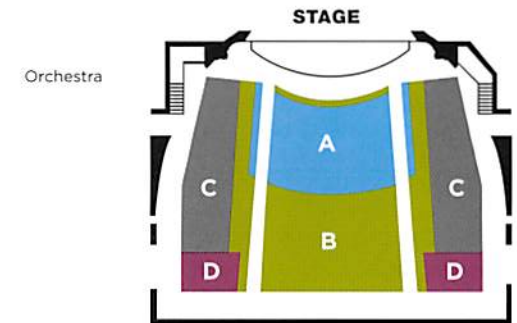

Please note that the first 2 aisle seats in "Orchestra Side" are included in the "Orchestra Center" section and price.



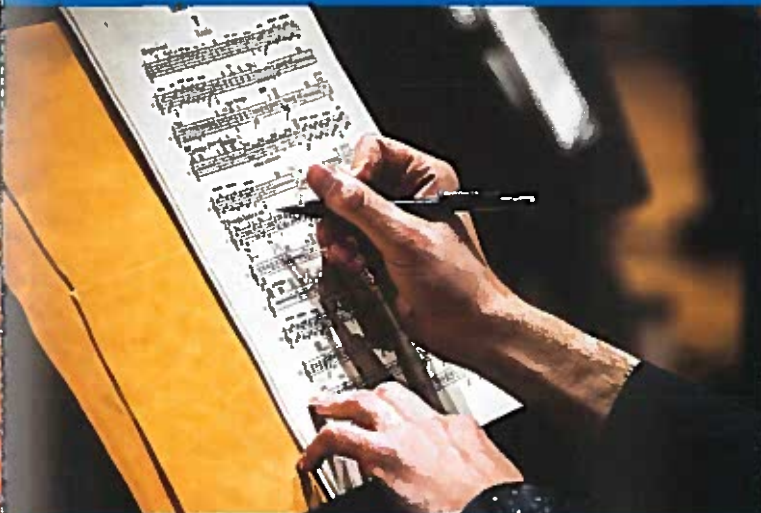
