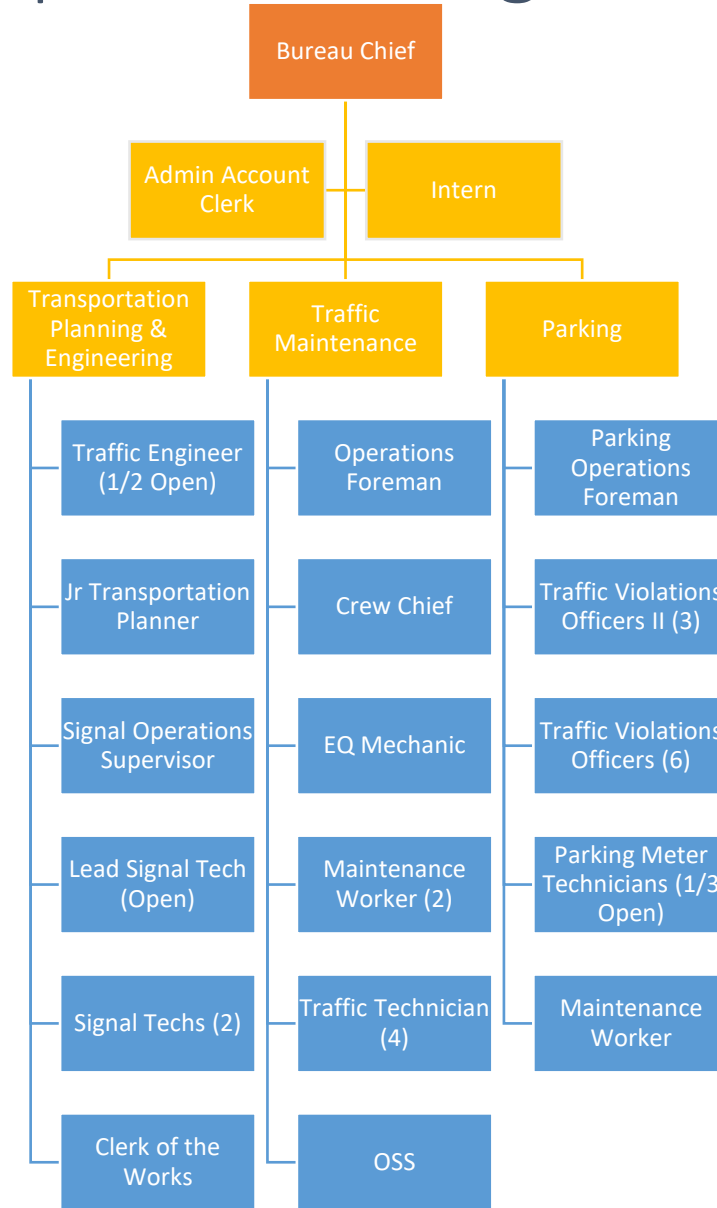
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# Department Introduction & Brief History

# Looking Back at FY 23/24

## Accomplishments

- Vision Zero Action Plan Underway
- Completion of Citywide Parking Study
- Outdoor Dining Program transformation
- Applied for \$40 Million in grants
- Created new Traffic Signal Operations Supervisor position
- Started rehabilitation of City Parking Garages
- Broke ground on Greenwich/Pulaski Roundabout
- Installed 10 new traffic signals
- 31% increase in parking ticket revenue
- Washington Blvd Roadway Safety Improvements

## Challenges

- Procurement difficulties
- Contractor availability
- Long lead times for grant funds
- Transportation Planning and Engineering, Parking staffing issues
- Lack of software

- Enhance roadway safety through the Vision Zero Program
- Launch new microtransit service
- Continue to aggressively apply for state and federal grants
- Break ground on several construction projects
- Launch safety speed camera program
