

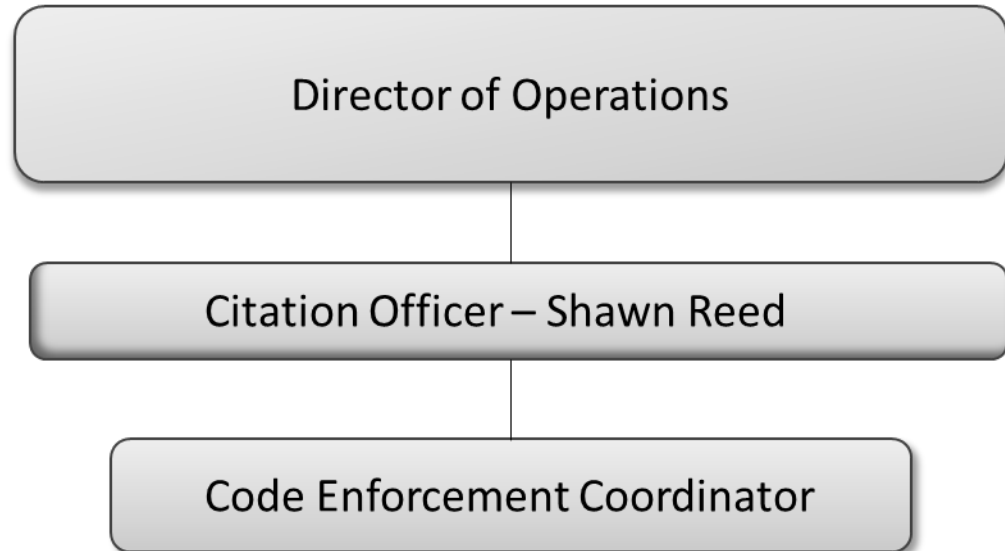

## **Budget Summary (FY 2025-26)**

**There are no new staffing changes to report. We are requesting an increase of \$25,000 to the 530006-Legal Expenses line item. With the increased use of the mayor's street to street program and a record number of 192 blight notices issued last year, we are expecting an increase in the number of blight cases being sent to our outside legal counsel.**

## **New or Expanded Services/Programs (FY 2026-27)**

## Key Challenges & Changes (FY 2026-27)

There has been an increase in the number of blight inspections conducted, citations issued, and overall volume of work on the blight department over the past year. There were staffing issues due to illness but the Director of Operation's cross training initiative has helped alleviate the problem.

No new changes are expected.

## Performance Improvements & Efficiencies:

- 1) The Land Use Clerk has cross trained and learned the code enforcement coordinator job in order to provide coverage for both departments.
- 2) Our budget will be balanced again this year.
