

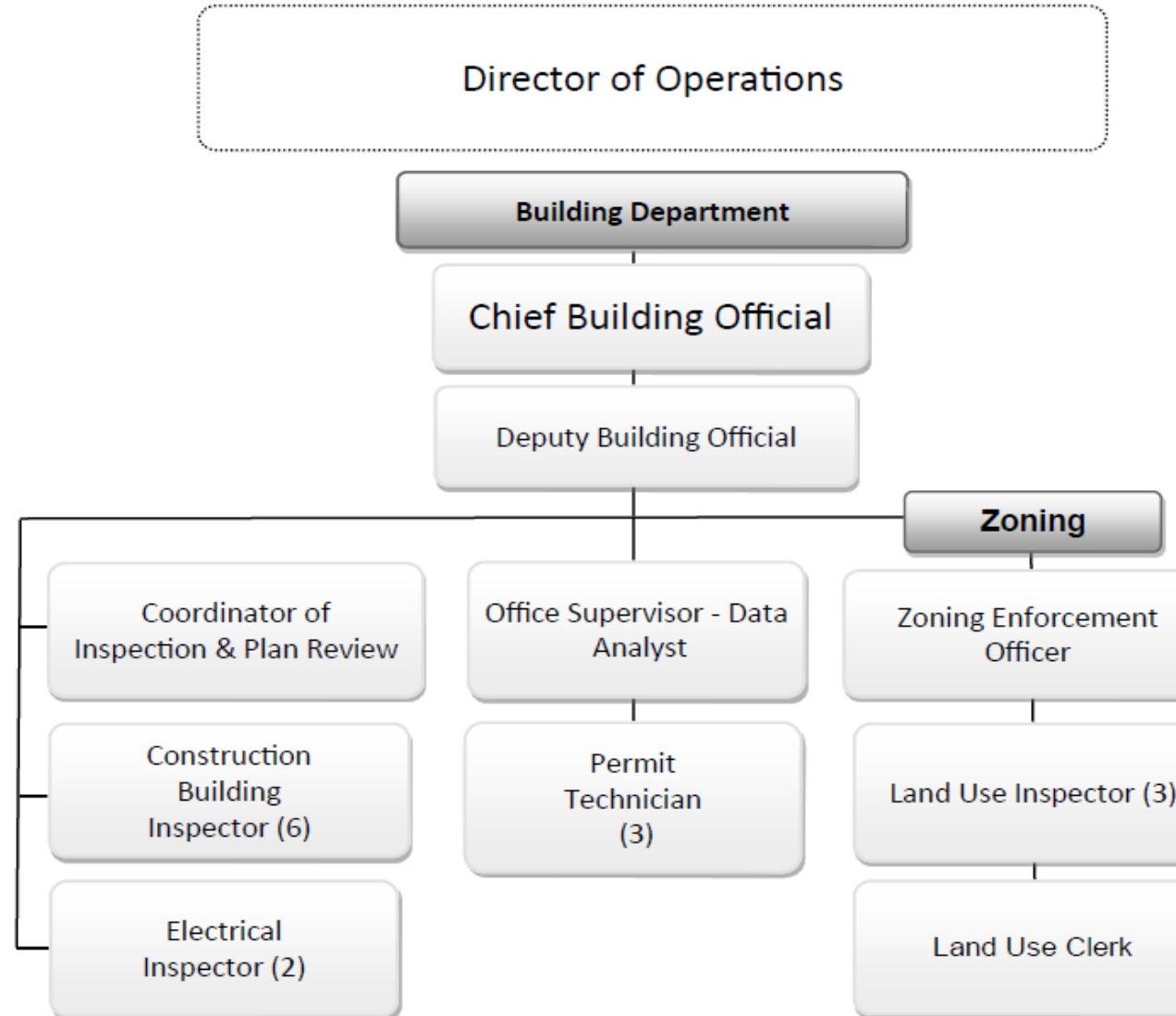

We have changed the Coordinator of Major Projects position to that of Deputy Building Official. The purpose of this change is to provide coverage for the department in the absence of the Chief Building Official. We are not requesting any increased funds for this budget.

Key Challenges & Changes (FY 2026-27)

Departmental Challenges & Anticipated Changes:

Some challenges we are still facing:

- 1) Potential launch of the oracle permitting software because it does not work and will not allow us to do our jobs.
- 2) An aging fleet system will affect our ability to do inspections as some cars will inevitably be out of service for repairs.
- 3) Lack of qualified applicants for open positions.

Anticipated changes:

None are expected at this time.

Performance Improvements & Efficiencies:

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- 1) We have changed the walk-in permitting schedule from bi-monthly to every Wednesday from 8:30-10:30am.
- 2) We have increased communication between the state building inspector's office and ours to implement a protocol for faster code interpretation requests.
- 3) Assigned specific plan reviewers for questions on daycares, code modification requests, accessibility issues, and school projects to ensure faster and more consistent answers.
