Person to Person (P2P) was founded in 1968 in response to the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and the recognition that decades of housing and social policies had contributed to deep economic disparities.

Today, P2P is a community-supported nonprofit that supports families and individuals as they move toward stability with healthy food, clothing, housing assistance, and access to pathways for economic opportunity.

THE NEED IN STAMFORD

High Cost of Living & Housing

- Top 10 most expensive places to live in the US
- 50% of renters are housing cost burdened
- *Longtime residents are being displaced*
- *Evictions harm families and communities*

Rising Food Insecurity & Homelessness

- 20% are food insecure (doubled since the pandemic)
- SNAP & Medicaid at risk for 18,000 local residents
- We provide 2X more food than in 2019
- *Poor nutrition harms health, education and social success*

15,000 Stamford Residents Served by P2P Programs

- 12% of Stamford residents use our services
- 60% of P2P clients are Stamford residents
- Summer Camperships in partnership with SPS Social Workers to identify SPS students most in need
- Financial Opportunity Center serves Stamford residents

CRITICAL NEEDS

Food Pantries provide food to prepare 2.5M meals each year

- Two full time mobile food pantries in Stamford serve 13 neighborhoods, 6 days/week, evenings and Saturdays
- Two full time neighborhood pantries (Darien and Norwalk)
- Door2Door home delivery to serve homebound & fearful immigrants
- People self-select from an array of healthy food designed by nutritionist for 3 meals/day for each member of the family

Emergency Financial Assistance

- Rent, security deposits, utility assistance
- Child enrichment, workforce training, medical bills
- Designed to prevent eviction and promote housing stability

Clothing Center

- Quality clothing, shoes and linens for the entire family





ECONOMIC SECURITY

Financial Opportunity Center

- Individual coaching model paired with financial support, workforce readiness coaching, and funding for skills training for Stamford residents

College Scholarships

- Financial assistance to qualifying Stamford students for book & tuition payments

Camperships

- Enriching summer experiences for Stamford K-5 students while their parents continue to work

Casework Services

- Seven full-time bilingual caseworkers provide wraparound services, referrals, and support

Help support Person to Person's Campership Program. You can provide children with a fun camp experience and give their parents peace of mind, knowing their children are safe and engaged while they are at work.

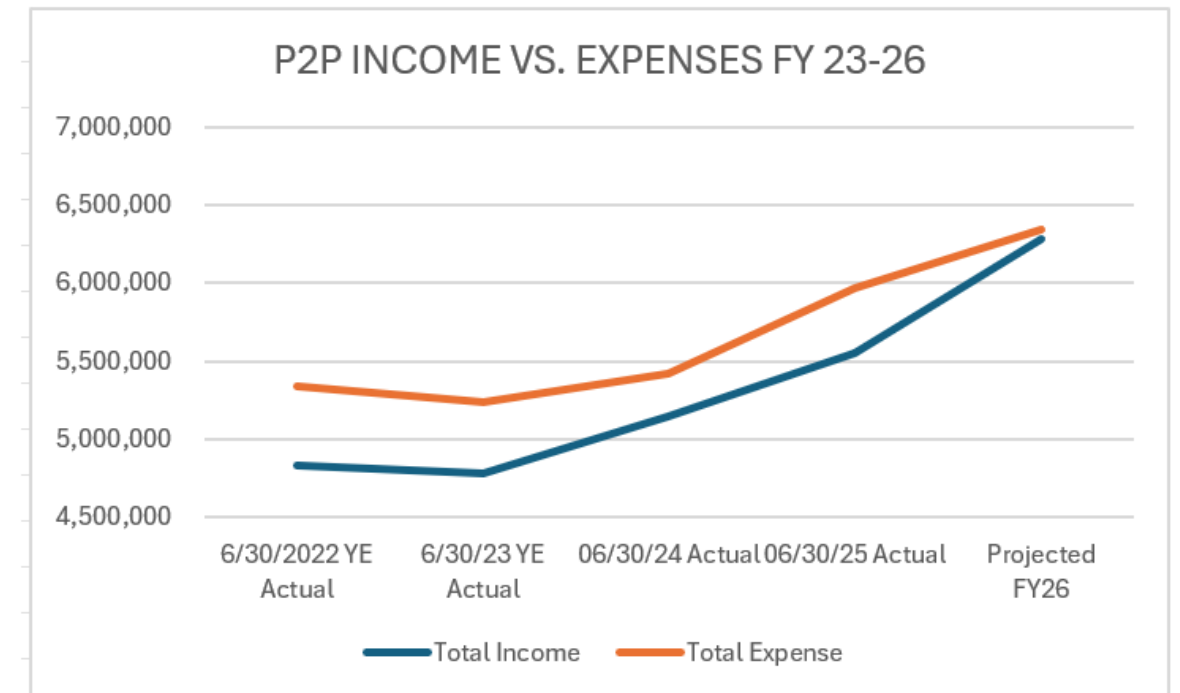
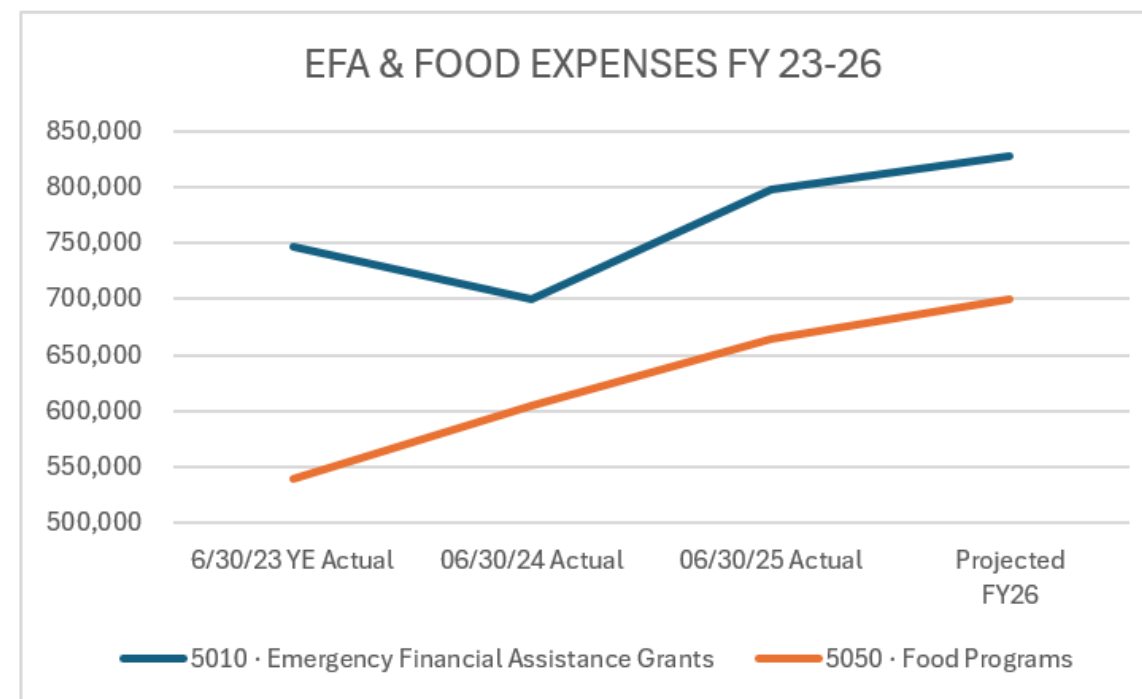
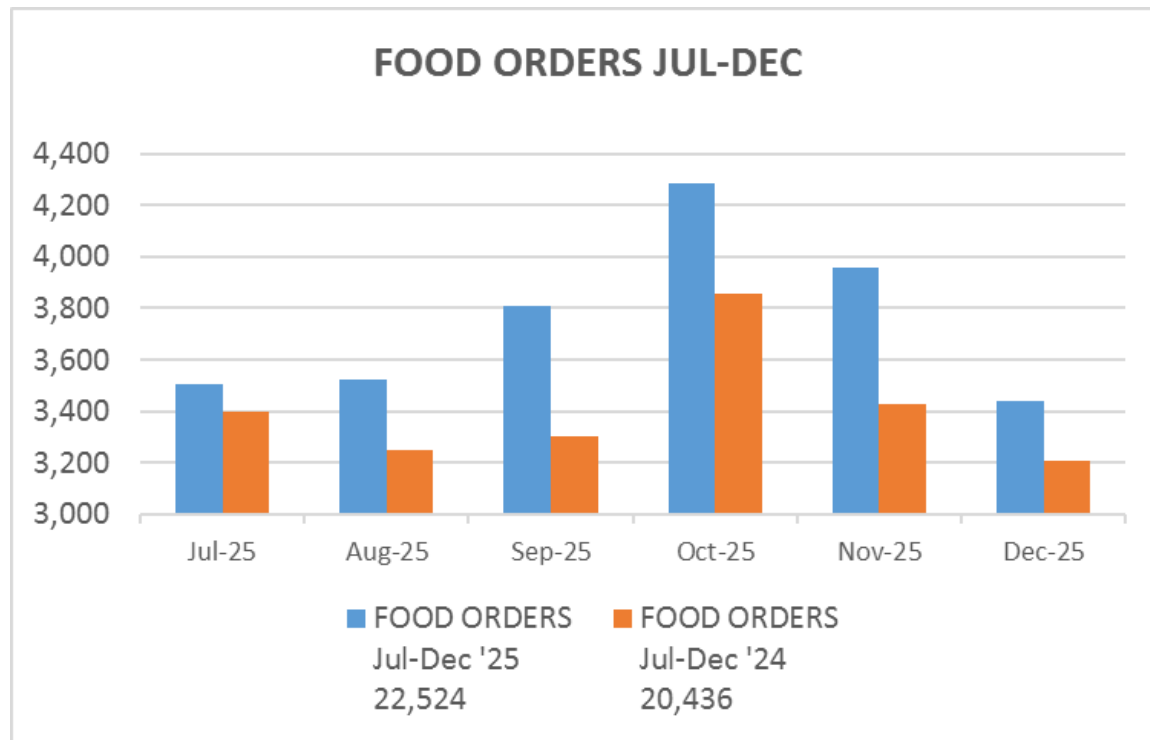




WE ARE EFFICIENT

- Over 90 cents of every \$1 is spent directly on programs
- With every \$1 donated, we can purchase \$5 worth of food
- Summer camp partners offer steep discounts to allow us to send 250+ children to camp
- We leverage 75,000 volunteer hours annually and \$10M donated food & clothing to serve 28,000 people annually
- We partner with schools, houses of worship, Charter Oak, government and nonprofits to serve the City and its residents
- We can provide a meal for \$1.20 - less than 20% what it would cost the City to feed its residents
